In this problem assume that the moon is only under the influence of the earth's gravitational force given by a magnitude  $\vec{\mathbf{F}}_{e,m} = -G\frac{m_e m_m}{r_{e,m}^2}\hat{\mathbf{r}}_{e,m}$ . Also assume that the moon is moving in a circular orbit around the earth and that the moon travels with a constant speed in that orbit. Let  $G = 6.67 \times 10^{-11} \, N - m^2/kg^2$ . The mass of the earth is  $m_e = 5.98 \times 10^{24} \, kg$ . The mass of the moon is  $m_m = 7.36 \times 10^{22} \, kg$ . The radius of the orbit is  $r_{e,m} = 3.8 \times 10^8 \, m$ .

- a) Briefly describe how you intend to model the motion of the object? What directions are you choosing for analyzing the components of your forces and state why?
- **b)** Calculate the period of the moon's orbit around the earth.
- **c**) Is this the same period as the time between full moons as seen from the earth? Explain your reasoning.
