"How Long? How Many?" record sheets

- 1. Each player uses a different 10-by-10 grid on the record sheet.
- On your turn, roll the die twice to find out which Cuisenaire Rods to take. The first roll tells "how long" a rod to use. The second roll tells "how many" rods to take.
- 3. Arrange the rods into a rectangle. Trace it on your grid. Write the multiplication sentence inside.
- 4. The game is over when one of you can't place your rectangle because there's no room on the grid.
- Figure out how many of your squares are covered and how many are uncovered. Check each other's answers.
- 6. Play again.
