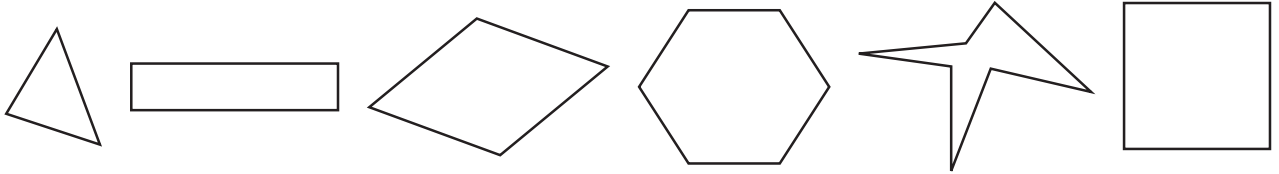


Identifying Polygons


Family Note

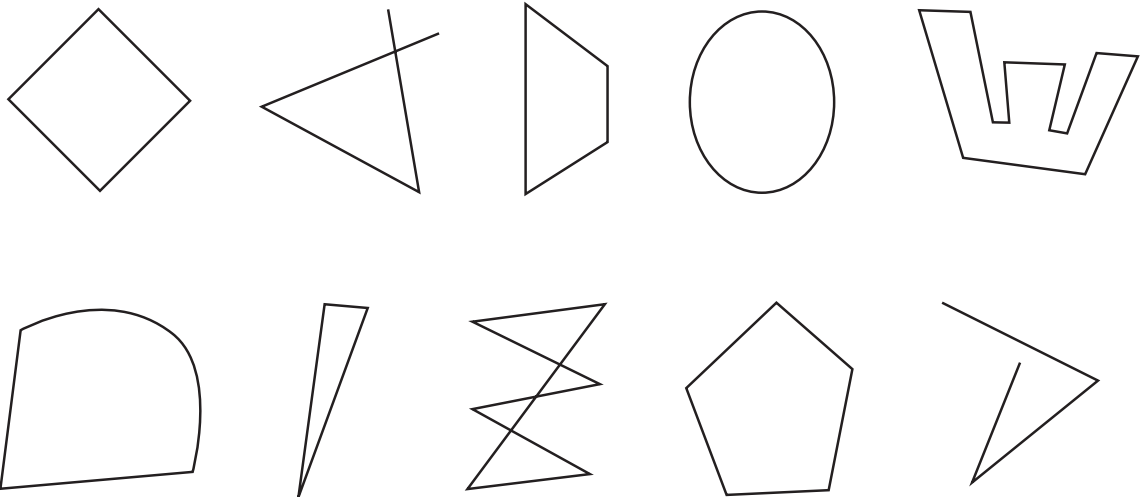
